RE: Returning Students

Dear Returning Students,

We are looking forward to your return for the **Spring 2023 semester**. Classes are scheduled to begin on Thursday, January 19, 2023. With you in mind, we have planned various engaging academic and social programs. Please note that *Returning Students* are to report as follows:

All returning **campus residents** may enter the residence halls on Sunday, January 14, 2023 beginning at 10:00 a.m. (CST). All returning students new to the residence halls must have already paid **the housing fee of \$300.00**. Students returning without verification that the housing fee has been paid will be required to submit a **Money Order for the \$300.00 prior to being assigned a room; financial aid should have been completed**.

Registration for classes will begin on Tuesday, January 17, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. (CST), in the *Student Connector*:

- Registration Fee-\$150.00 (**Fee is required for all students new to the campus and those that were not registered during the Fall 2022 semester**).
- Housing Fee-\$300.00 (**Residence Halls are filling up fast so get your fee in to reserve your room**). All residence halls open, on Sunday, January 14, 2023.

All **non-campus residents** will report on Tuesday, January 17, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. (CST), to the *Student Connector*, to begin the registration process. Registration is completed with the issuance of a 2023 Spring ID Card. Please note that classes will begin at 8:00am, Thursday, January 19, 2023. ***All students must present a valid Spring 2023 Texas College Identification Card to begin classes.**

As the College seeks to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all, wearing a mask on campus and COVID-19 testing weekly is required for all students, faculty and staff. Additionally, all students seeking to move into on campus housing must submit proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 24 hours prior to arriving at the College. Any student without proof of a negative test will be tested upon entering the campus and prior to being permitted to register or move into the housing facilities. If arriving after business hours, students must have proof of a negative test taken within 24 hours.

I hope the information provided will be helpful as you make preparations to attend the 2023 Spring semester.
