We are excited that you will be joining us for the 2023 spring semester, which classes are scheduled to begin on Thursday, January, 19, 2023. With you in mind; we have planned various engaging academic and social programs. Please note that *New Students* are to report as follows:

All **new student campus residents** are to report to the *Gus F. Taylor Gymnasium* for check-in and housing assignments on Friday, January, 13, 2023, at 10:00am. There will be a mandatory orientation which will begin promptly at 1:00pm. Make sure you've paid your housing fee as rooms are filling up quickly.

All **new student non-campus residents** are to report to the *Gus F. Taylor Gymnasium*, on Friday, January, 13, 2023, for a mandatory orientation which will begin promptly at 1:00pm.

Please note that *Returning Students* are to report as follows:


All **returning student campus residents** may return to the residence halls on Saturday, January, 14, 2023, beginning at 10:00am **providing the housing fee of \$300.00 has been received in the Office of Business & Finance and financial aid has been completed**. Students returning without verification that the housing fee has been paid will be required to submit a Money Order for the \$300.00 prior to being assigned a room. Registration for classes will begin on Tuesday, January, 17, 2023, at 9:00am in the *McKinney Hall Connector*:

- Registration Fee-\$150.00 (**Fee is required for all students at the time of Registration**).
- Housing Fee-\$300.00 (**Residence Halls are filling up fast so get your fee in to reserve your room**). All residence halls open, on Saturday, January, 14, 2023.

All **returning student non-campus residents** will report on Tuesday, January, 17, 2023 at 9:00am, in the *McKinney Hall Connector*, to begin the registration process. Please note that classes will begin at 8:00am, Thursday, January, 19, 2023. All students must present a valid spring 2023 Texas College Identification Card to begin classes.

All students returning to the campus will be required to provide a Negative COVID-19 test, taken within 24 hours of arriving on campus. The nurses will be on campus until 4:00pm each day to assist with testing however anyone arrive after that time, will not be permitted on campus without the test results.
